Run 4 Wales offers a fun and practical experience for your team which delivers a real contribution to your local community. We recruit from 150 to 1500 volunteers for our events.

Corporate volunteering offers a great chance to get out of the office if your team is office-based or bring them together in a fresh environment if they are home-based. Volunteering at a Run 4 Wales event helps your team have fun, learn new skills and promotes mental and physical well-being by having a day outdoors. Being part of a mass race, seeing thousands of runners achieve their dreams, is an uplifting and inspiring experience.





Water Stations around the course offer a great chance to be at the heart of the action.

You'll help set up the water station, opening thousands of bottles of water to hand out to runners and cheer them on as they pass by.

**Course Marshals** play a vital role in directing and motivating runners as they tackle the route.

The course marshal teams are the eyes and ears of the race, keeping everyone safe and reporting any incidents to Event Control.





The **Finish Team** greet runners as they finish their race, handing out medals, water, t-shirts and fruit.

Before the race volunteers will help the Bag Drop team at their busiest time or support the start pens, guiding runners into the correct areas.

Runners can choose to leave a bag at the **Bag Drop Tent** during the race.

This is a great opportunity to have a chat with runners both before and after the race, while ensuring their bag is safely stored.
